RULES

Scouting America's Pinewood Derby Car Building Rules

All cars must pass the following inspection to qualify for the race:

- 1. Width shall not exceed 2-3/4 inches.
- 2. Length shall not exceed 7 inches.
- 3. Weight shall not exceed 5 ounces.
- 4. Axles, wheels, and body shall be from the materials provided in the kit. Additional wheels can be purchased separately.
- 5. Wheel bearings, washers, and bushings are prohibited.
- 6. No lubricating oil may be used. Axles may be lubricated with powdered graphite or silicone.
- 7. The car shall not ride on any kind of spring.
- 8. The car must be free-wheeling, with no starting devices.
- 9. No loose materials of any kind are allowed in the car.
- 10. Height shall not exceed 4 inches.

Pack 200's Pinewood Derby Race Rules

- 1. Three cars race simultaneously.
- 2. Third place finishers receive 2 points.
- 3. Second place finishers receive 1 point.
- 4. First place finishers receive 0 points.
- 5. Cars are eliminated after they receive 4 points.
- 6. Races continue until 1 car remains.

Pack 200's Outlaw Race Rules

- 1. Cars may ignore Car Building Rules 3-9
- 2. Race is only open to adults and Pinewood Derby winners.
- 3. Other than the above exceptions, the Outlaw Race follows the same format as the Pinewood Deby
